## NEIL H. RUTTENBERG, Esq.

Neil Ruttenberg is a graduate of the University of North Carolina. Mr. Ruttenberg graduated with a degree in economics and won his letter as a heavy weight wrestler. After marrying the former Judith Gottfried, he earned his law degree from Columbia University.

Mr. Ruttenberg began his practice of law with the Office of the General Counsel of the Navy (OGC). At the same time he became the General Counsel of Presearch, Incorporated, a defense contractor located in Northern, Virginia.

Today Mr. Ruttenberg is a sole practitioner and continues to operate Triple D. He is also the long standing Parliamentarian of the National Contract Management Association (NCMA).
